A government issued photo ID with expiration date is required, such as:

- Iowa Driver's License
- Iowa Non-Operator ID
- Iowa Voter Identification Card (with PIN, number & signed)
- · Note: UI Student ID can't be used


#### YOU CAN REGISTER AND VOTE EARLY AT THE SAME TIME

#### **Get your Absentee Ballot Request form:**



#### Submit your Absentee Ballot Request form August 27 thru October 21:

- Mail to: Johnson County Auditor, 913 S. Dubuque St. Iowa City, IA 52240
- Deliver to: the Johnson County Auditor's Office between 8:00am-5:00pm.

#### **Receive your Absentee Ballot:**

Ballots will be mailed out beginning October 16th.

# **COMPLETE YOUR BALLOT**

Follow the instructions that come with your ballot to make sure your ballot counts.

# **RETURN YOUR BALLOT**

#### **By mail:**

- · Postage is prepaid.
- Your ballot must reach the auditor's office by November 5, at 8:00pm, so mail your ballot early!

-OR-

#### **By hand:**

- Put in the ballot drop-box near the Johnson County Auditor's Office
- · Hand the ballot to the Auditor's Office staff.
- · Ask a relative or member of your household to return your ballot.
- · If none of these options work, call the Auditor's Office.
- Note: Campaign volunteers cannot handle a ballot.

# **VOTE ON ELECTION DAY**

## **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5** 7:00am-8:00pm

# WHERE TO VOTE

- On Election Day you must vote at the polling place assigned to your precinct.
- · If you go to the wrong polling place, do not vote a provisional ballot. That ballot cannot be counted. Go to the correct polling place for your precinct.
- Note: On Election Day, you cannot vote at the Auditor's Office.

#### Valid forms of ID to show on election day:

A government issued photo ID with expiration date is required, such as:

- Iowa Driver's License
- Iowa Non-Operator ID
- Voter Identification Card (with PIN, number & signed)
- · Note: UI Student ID can't be used

#### What if you have moved?:

If your ID does not show your current address, you will be asked for proof of address. The proof (paper or electronic) must have your name, your address, and be valid within the last 45 days, such as:

- Residential lease
- Utility bill
- Cell phone bill
- · Bank statement
- · Paycheck
- Other government document

If you cannot prove who you are and where you live, a registered voter from your precinct may attest for you. That person will have to show valid ID.

## YOU CAN REGISTER AND VOTE AT THE SAME TIME

However, recently expired IDs are not accepted for same-day registration.
